- 1. Consider and approve a Mayor Pro Tem. Rogers motioned to nominate Louis Dunn as the Mayor Pro Tem and was seconded by Smith.
 - **Motion Passed: 4-0**
- 2. Consider and approve an additional \$83,793 due to material inflation to complete all projects included in the original bid for the TWDB CWSRF Project 73851. It was determined in the May meeting that our original project goals would no longer be attainable given the inflation of the past few years. Rogers motioned to approved the additional \$83,793 in committed funds to ensure the project gets completed as projected. Goggans seconded the motion to approve the funds.
