4. Consider and consider the sale of 205 NE Front St which currently houses the EEDC. After discussion of getting the building appraised, a motion was made by Dunn and seconded by Goggans to sell the building by sealed bid. A minimum will be decided in the next council meeting after appraisal.

Motion Passed: 4-0


