New Business:

1. Consider and approve Budget Ordinance 08262024 for the 2024-2025 Fiscal Year Budget. Pendleton motioned to approve Budget Ordinance 08262024 and was seconded by Rogers.

2. Consider an approve Ordinance #0820624 pertaining to the rules regulating the use of Edgewood City Lake and repealing Ordinance #010813 for the same. An immediate amendment requiring minors sixteen (16) and under require adult supervision was requested. Pendleton motioned to approve with the amendment and was seconded by Rogers.

3. Consider and approve splitting the cost of \$5,250 for the City Lake survey with the Police Department Special Fund for a cost of \$2,625 each. Dunn motioned to approve and was seconded by Goggans.




Open Forum/Citizen Comments: None
