### **Consent Agenda:**

This account will have the signers of Steve Steadham, Petra Marley and Kathleen Jordan. Dunn motioned to approve and was seconded by Pendleton.

3. Consider and approve Resolution 120924A Supporting the Proposed Rehabilitation of the Development of Edgewood Seniors community at 300 E Elm St, Edgewood, TX 75117. Dunn motioned to approve and was seconded by Goggans.

**Motion Passed: 4-0**
