Edgewood City Council met in a regular session.

Consent Agenda:

Upon a motion made by council members Dunn and Smith, the council voted to approve the Consent Agenda consisting of the August 11, 2025 City Council minutes, August 25, 2025 Special Meeting minutes and paying of the August expenses.

Motion Carried 5-0

New Business:

1. Consider and approve the Ratification Vote on adopting a tax rate of .565262 for the 2025-2026 Fiscal year. Crabb motioned to approve the rate and was seconded by Goggans.
Motion Passed: 5-0
2. Consider and approve adopting Ordinance 09082025 levying a tax rate of .565262 for the 2025-2026 Fiscal Year. Parker motioned to approve and was seconded by Dunn.
Motion Passed: 5-0
3. Consider and approve Ordinance 090825 amending Chapter 18, offenses and miscellaneous provisions by adding Article VI. Section 18-100, Prohibition on the unauthorized placement, erection, or maintenance of temporary shelters on designated public property; and by adding section 8-200, sleeping in a public place; providing a penalty, providing for the repeal of conflicting ordinances; providing for severability and providing an effective date. Smith motioned to approve and was seconded by Crabb.
Motion Passed: 5-0
4. Consider and approve Ordinance 090825-A amending Chapter 105, Building by adding Article III – Alarms; providing a penalty, providing for the repeal of conflicting ordinances; providing for severability and providing an effective date. Parker motioned to approve and was seconded by Goggans.
Motion Passed: 5-0
5. Discuss and consider asphalt street repairs on TWDB-CWSRF project. After a lengthy conversation, it was decided that a meeting was necessary with the City

Attorney before moving forward. Crabb motioned to table the item and was seconded by Goggans.

Motion Tabled


6. Consider and approve opening a checking account for the City of Edgewood Municipal Court Consolidated Security and Technology Fund with authorized signers of Stevan Steadham, Petra Marley and Kathleen Jordan. A new state law mandates that the pre-existing Court Security and Court Technology Funds be combined. Dunn motioned to approve and was seconded by Goggans.

Motion Passed: 5-0


Departmental reports were given by Administrator Marley, Chief Morrison and Secretary Jordan.
