Consent Agenda:

Upon a motion made by council members Crabb and Parker, the council voted to approve the Consent Agenda consisting of the September 8, 2025 City Council minutes, September 15, 2025 Special Meeting minutes and paying of the September expenses.

New Business:

1. Consider and approve the Edgewood Economic Development Corporation 2025-2026 Budget as presented. Dunn motioned to approve the budget and was seconded by Parker.
Motion Passed: 5-0
2. Consider and take action on Edgewood Economic Development Corporations nominations for 5 board positions. The nomination are Wendi Conley, Valeria Fain, Lindsay Williams, Lance Simmons and Brad Henderson. Dunn motioned to approve and was seconded by Goggans.
Motion Passed: 5-0
3. Consider and approve Ordinance 101325 amending the City of Edgewood Original Budget for the October 1, 2024 through September 30, 2025 budget. Smith motioned to approve and was seconded by Goggans.
Motion Passed: 5-0
4. Consider and approve renewing the 13 Month Certificate of Deposit. Fed rates have dropped lowering the rate to 3.5%. Parker motioned to approve and was seconded by Crabb.
Motion Passed: 5-0
5. Consider and approve the updated fee schedule for sanitation rates from BlackJack Disposal effective 10-1-2025. Crabb motioned to approve and was seconded by Parker
Motion Passed: 5-0
6. Discuss and consider a petition requesting annexation, to include municipal services, of Property ID R000010483, 25.13 acres located a N Livingston and

VZCR 3601. The platted property includes 17 potential residential homesites and includes a variance for a septic systems given in the April 2025 meeting. Parker motioned to approve the petition and was seconded by Goggans.

7. Discuss and consider a petition requesting annexation, to include municipal services, of Property ID R000011619, 0.43 acres located at 15996 US Hwy 80. This site contains a structure built without inspections requesting to be annexed "as is" for the use of city sewer services. It was determined that this item would be tabled until the property and structure could come in to compliance with all city ordinances and would be denied in the "as is" state it currently stands. Parker motioned to table and was seconded by Goggans.

Motion Tabled


Departmental reports were given by Administrator Marley, Chief Morrison and Secretary Jordan.
