

City of Edgewood, Texas Council Meeting Minutes

November 17, 2025 at 6:30pm

Edgewood City Council met in a special session.

Council members present were Mayor Steve Steadham, Charlie Crabb, Chuck Parker, and Ruby Smith. Council Members Inez Goggans and Louis Dunn were absent. City Administrator Petra Marley, City Secretary Kathleen Jordan and Chief John Morrison were also present. Prayer was led by Charlie Crabb and pledge was led by Ruby Smith.

Open Forum/Citizen Comments: N/A

New Business:

1. Discuss and take action regarding the TWDB 2020 project as it pertains to McKinney & Moore negotiations and project completion. Mike Tibbets informed council of further negotiation communications with McKinney & Moore of Texas through the negotiating authority granted to the City Administrator in the September 15, 2025 meeting. Parker motioned to proceed with contacting the City's legal resources and exploring next steps and was seconded by Crabb.

Motion Passed: 3-0

2. Consider and approve the 2025 Tax Roll as presented by the Van Zandt County Appraisal District in the amount of \$700,423.93. Parker motioned to approve the presented tax roll and was seconded by Crabb.

Motion Passed: 3-0

3. Consider and approve the Water/Sewer Fund to pay \$152,594.75 to the General Fund which is 50% of the total purchase price, \$305,189.50, for R000010553 consisting of 43.518 acres adjacent to the WWTP located on PR 7625 for future infrastructure improvements. Smith motioned to approve the payment of funds from Water/Sewer to General Fund and was seconded by Parker.


Motion Passed: 3-0


4. Consider and approve a budget amendment to code 1016200 (G/F Police, Equipment Purchases) for the purchase of a 2026 Dodge Durango Pursuit vehicle at the cost of \$74,970.00. It was decided an amendment would not be needed and financing would be acquired. Purchasing this cruiser will retire the two (2) 2010 Tahoes that have reached life expectancy and have become a burden to maintain. Parker motioned to approve and was seconded by Crabb.

Motion Passed: 3-0
