Edgewood City Council met in a regular session.

Consent Agenda:

Upon a motion made by council members Smith and Dunn, the council voted to approve the Consent Agenda consisting of the January 12, 2025 council minutes and paying of the January expenses.

New Business:

1. Consider and approve the 2024-2025 Fiscal Year Audit presented by Mike Ward of Mike Ward Accounting & Financial Consulting, LLC. Mr. Mike Ward presented and reviewed the 2024-2025 final audit for the City of Edgewood. Dunn motioned to approve as presented and was seconded by Parker.

2. Consider and approve the Engagement Letter by Mike Ward Accounting & Financial Consulting LLC for the 2025-2026 fiscal year audit. Dunn motioned to approve and was seconded by Smith.

Public Hearing: Proposed Annexation of 25.13-acre tract of land situated in TJ

Shaw Survey, Abstract No. 759 with Property ID: 000010483

3. Consider and approve Ordinance 02092026 annexing the hereinafter described territory to the City of Edgewood, Van Zandt County, Texas, and extending the Boundary limits of said city so as to include said hereinafter described property being a 25.13-acre tract of land situated in TJ Shaw Survey, Abstract No. 759 with Property ID: 000010483. Parker motioned to approve Ordinance 02092026 in favor of annexing Property ID: 000010483 and was seconded by Dunn.

4. Consider and approve the EEDC's request to purchase a dock for the City Lake Park in the interest of the community from Hotwood's in the amount of \$25,815.00. The dock will be comprised of aluminum with a 4' x 32' walkway leading out to a

8'x32' floating dock. Crabb motioned to approved the EEDC's purchase and was seconded by Dunn.

Motion Passed: 5-0

5. Consider and approve a budget amendment to line item 1016010 (Police Salaries) adding an additional \$12,000 a year to the current salary of the Director of Public Safety and Works. Smith motioned to approve and was seconded by Dunn.

Motion Passed: 5-0

6. Consider and approve closing the Road, Bridge and Drainage checking account and returning the unused funds plus interest to the General Fund Operating account in the amount of \$51,904.07. Dunn motioned approve closing the account plus any additional interest and returning the money to the General Fund Account and was seconded by Smith.

Motion Passed: 5-0

7. Consider and approve closing the Series 2023 Revenue Bond Construction Fund checking account (Clearwell Construction Account) and returning the unused funds plus interest to the Water Sewer Fund Operating account in the amount of \$24,940.43. Parker motioned approve closing the account plus any additional interest and returning the money to the Water Sewer Fund Account and was seconded by Dunn.

Motion Passed: 5-0

8. Consider and take action on possible resolutions of the TWDB-CWSRF Sewer Line project in relation to McKinney and Moore of Texas, LLC. Executive session was not utilized as the Attorney was not necessary. Administrator Marley gave a positive update also indicating that some details remain to be worked out. Due to no decisions needing to be made, no motions were made and no votes were taken.
