Edgewood City Council met in a regular session.

A quorum was formed with Mayor Louis Dunn, Charlie Crabb, Inez Goggans, Chuck Parker, Ruby Smith and Codey Barrons. Staff present were City Administrator Petra Marley, City Secretary Kathleen Jordan, Chief John Morrison and Judge Maria Goggans.

Consent Agenda:

Upon a motion made by council members Smith and Parker, the council voted to approve the Consent Agenda consisting of the May 11, 2026 council minutes and paying of the May expenses.

Motion Carried 5-0

New Business:

1. Consider and take action on adopting Ordinance 060826-1 relating to Regulation of Recreational Vehicle Parks; Providing Definitions; Providing Minimum Requirements; Providing Restrictions on Locations; Providing Exceptions; Providing Penalties for Violation of the Ordinance; Providing for Severability; and Establishing an Effective Date. Parker motioned to approve and was seconded by Crabb.

Motion Passed: 5-0

2. Consider and take action on adopting Ordinance 060826-2 relating to Zoning; Special Use Regulations – Data Centers; Providing Definitions; Providing Minimum Requirements; Providing Penalties for Violation of the Ordinance; Providing for Severability; and Establishing an Effective Date. Crabb motioned to approve and was seconded by Barrons.

Motion Passed: 5-0

3. Consider and take action on adopting Ordinance 060826-3 Amending Chapter 10, Business Regulations, Article V. Temporary Businesses, Section 10-351 Definitions, and Section 10-352 Permit Required in the Code of Ordinances of the City of Edgewood. An amendment was made to come in to compliance with new state law regulating mobile food vendors. Parker motioned to approve and was seconded by Goggans.

Motion Passed: 5-0

4. Consider and take action on the temporary closure of a portion of Shady Lane for the Edgewood Volunteer Fire Department's Community Event and Blood Drive. The FD is requesting that Shady Lane beginning at Bulldog Lane and ending at the stop sign be closed for the midday activities. Parker motioned to approve in community interest and was seconded by Barrons.

Motion Passed: 5-0



Consider and take action on accepting the donation of 205 W Pecan St also known as property ID 8688 and 8689 (Lots 11 & 12) located in block 29 or Original Edgewood from the Vasquez Family to be used for the benefit of the Edgewood Veteran's Memorial. A letter was presented to council on behalf of the family wishing to donate the property and be used in benefit of the Veteran's Memorial understanding that the Memorial will not be placed there in residential zoning. Crabb motioned to accept the donation and was seconded by Smith.

Motion Passed: 5-0


Departmental reports were given by Administrator Marley, Secretary Jordan, Chief Morrison, and Judge Goggans.
