

City of Edgewood, Texas Council Meeting Minutes

July 13, 2026 at 6:30pm

Edgewood City Council met in a regular session.

A quorum was formed with Mayor Louis Dunn, Charlie Crabb, Inez Goggans, Chuck Parker, Ruby Smith and Codey Barrons. Staff present were City Administrator Petra Marley, City Secretary Kathleen Jordan, Chief John Morrison and Judge Maria Goggans.

Prayer was led by Mayor Dunn and pledge was led by Ruby Smith.

Guests: TXU Representative Connie Shaffer, Tommy and Valeria Fain (EDC Member).

Open Forum/Citizen Comments: N/A

Consent Agenda:

Upon a motion made by council members Parker and Smith, the council voted to approve the Consent Agenda consisting of the June 8, 2026 council minutes and paying of the June expenses.

Motion Carried 5-0

New Business:

1. Consider and take action on authorizing the City Administrator, Petra Marley, to sign a renewal of the City's electric rate, to begin January 1, 2030, when the market produces a rate to the Council's satisfaction set in this meeting after a presentation by TXU Representative Connie Shaffer. After presenting a variety of options to the council and further discussion, Smith motioned to approve signing a renewal contract for an 80-month term and was seconded by Barrons.

Motion Passed: 5-0

2. Consider and take action approving a budget amendment to Code 1015080, Building Maintenance, in the amount of \$27,400. 4K Construct replaced the leaking roof of City Hall buildings (103-107 NE Front) and provided mold remediation services in the Meeting/Council Room. The original bid for repair had been approved in the April 2026 meeting. Parker motioned to approved the budget amendment and was seconded by Goggans.

Motion Passed: 5-0

3. Consider and take action to approve Resolution 260713 authorizing the submission of an application for financial assistance through the Texas Water Development Board (TWDB) Water Supply and Infrastructure Grant Program (WSIG) in an amount not to exceed \$450,000 for water system and infrastructure improvements; designating the City's authorized representatives to complete the application; and authorizing the City Mayor to act on behalf of the City in all matters relating to the application. Parker motioned to approve and was seconded by Goggans.

Motion Passed: 5-0

4. Consider and take action on Resolution No 260713-1 approving the Municipal Maintenance Agreement with the Texas Department of Transportation. Tx DOT asked for an updated agreement to replace the current agreement signed 10 years

prior. Barrons motioned to approve the updated TxDOT Agreement and was seconded by Smith.

Motion Passed: 5-0

5. Consider and take action on Resolution No 260713-2 approving an Agreement for the Temporary Closure of a State Right of Way being FM 859 for the 52nd Annual Edgewood Halloween Carnival on October 31, 2026. A TxDOT permit is required for temporary closures of state roads. Smith motioned to approve and was seconded by Goggans.

Motion Passed: 5-0

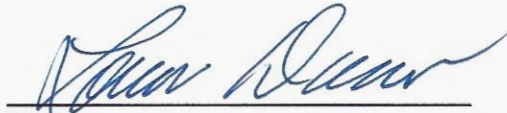
6. Consider and take action on designating Van Zandt Newspaper as the official City newspaper. Parker motioned to approve and was seconded by Crabb.

Motion Passed: 5-0

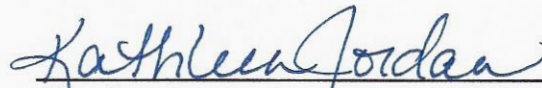
Departmental reports were given by Administrator Marley, Secretary Jordan, Chief Morrison, and Judge Goggans.
