



Boil Water Notice Rescinded

**FOR THE FOLLOWING ADDRESSES LOCATED AT:
LEE STREET, VZCR 3504, VZCR 3505, VZCR 3506, AND VZCR 3519**

September 17, 2026

On **September 15, 2026**, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality required the **City of Edgewood** public water system, **PSW ID 2340002**, to issue a Boil Water Notice to inform customers, individuals, or employees that due to conditions which occurred recently in the public water system, the water from this public water system was required to be boiled prior to use for drinking water or human consumption purposes.

The public water system has taken the necessary corrective actions to restore the quality of the water distributed by this public water system used for drinking water or human consumption purposes and has provided TCEQ with laboratory test results that indicate that the water no longer requires boiling prior to use as of **September 17, 2026**.
